

## PDMP Clinician Guide

In this guide, you will learn the documentation steps needed to meet the Query of a State Prescription Drug Monitoring Program (PDMP) Measure. Beginning in 2023, this is a required measure for Promoting Interoperability.

**Clinicians must access their state PDMP outside of iKM to run the required patient query.**

These steps should be completed prior to the electronic transmission of a controlled substance prescription.
