Controlling High Blood Pressure

In this lesson you will learn how to enter the required fields for the MIPS #236 Controlling High Blood Pressure quality measure.

The required fields for this quality measure are:


- Diagnosis of hypertension that is ACTIVE in the chart starting before and continuing into the measurement period or starting during the first six months of the measurement period
- Blood pressure results entered for patient visit
 - NOTE: if no blood pressure recorded during the reporting period will be assumed to be uncontrolled blood pressure

Exclusions for this measure are:

- Hospice, pregnancy, ESRD, dialysis, renal transplant, or palliative care at any time during reporting period
- Patients 66 years and older living in a nursing home long term
- Patients 66 80 years with:
 - · Advanced illness with 2 EM in current or prior year
 - Advanced illness with 1 inpatient visit in current year or prior year
 - Prescribed dementia medication(s) in current year or year prior
- Patients 81 years and older with indication of frailty during the measurement period



Note: Patients are not included in the numerator evaluation on dates where chemotherapy or radiation treatment is given.




1. Under the Clinical Profile tab, click Problems


2. Click ADD PROBLEM



- 3. In the search bar, type hypertension.
- 4. Select the **essential hypertension** diagnosis.




- 5. Using the calendar widget select the diagnosis date.
- 6. Click on ICD-10.




- 7. Select the I10 Essential (primary) hypertension code.
- 8. Click SAVE & CLOSE



If the patient's hypertension diagnosis resolves, you will need to update the diagnosis on the problem list. This will avoid the patient being included in future measurement periods for the measure.



9. To edit the diagnosis, click on hypertension in the problem list.



- 10. Click on the button next to **Resolved**.
- 11. Using the calendar widget select the date the hypertension resolved.
- 12. Click SAVE & CLOSE



Patients living in a nursing home on a long-term basis are excluded from this measure. To document this, go to the **Patient Hx** tab under **Clinical Profile.**



- 13. Click on Social History on the left side menu.
- 14. Click on the arrow to expand the Living Environment section



15. Click the radio button next to **Nursing Home**.



16. Click SAVE.
