In this lesson, you will learn the required documentation for the **MIPS# PIMSH17: Oncology: Utilization of Prophylactic GCSF for Cancer Patients Receiving Low-Risk Chemotherapy** quality measure. This is an inverse measure.

Patients will be included in the denominator if they have an E&M visit in the reporting period and have an order for GCSF by their established clinician within 7 days of IV or oral chemotherapy.

Established Clinician = 1 or more visits with the patient in the reporting year.

9. To see if GCSF was ordered within 7 days of chemotherapy, click the **Flowsheet**  tab.
10. Check to see if the patient was given IV chemotherapy, indicated by a  next to the medication, or if an oral chemotherapy medication was ordered.
11. Check to see if a GCSF was ordered within 7 days of the chemotherapy. If so, this will meet the numerator requirement.
