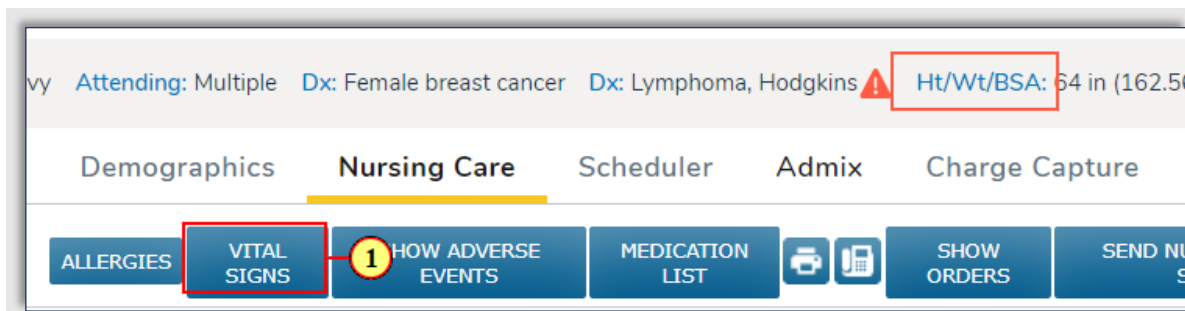


Pain Intensity Quantified

In this lesson you will learn the required documentation for the **MIPS #143 Pain Intensity Quantified** quality measure.



1. Access the **Daily Vitals window** by clicking **VITAL SIGNS** in the **Nursing Care** tab or by clicking the **Ht/Wt/BSA:** vitals button located in the patient banner.

2. In the **Daily Vitals** window, use the drop-down arrow to select the number that corresponds with the pain the patient is currently experiencing. 0 = no pain and 10 = the worst pain imaginable.

3. **Select** the number reported by the patient.

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4. Click [+ Add comment](#) to add any comments related to the patient's pain score.

5. Click [SAVE](#).

A pain score may also be documented under **Nursing Care** tab.

6. Click the checkbox under the **Yes** Column next to **Pain (grading scale)**.

7. Select the patient reported pain score from the drop-down list.

8. Click [SAVE](#).
