

The patient must have two E/M visits in the reporting year.


The documentation requires:

- Diagnosis of cancer (from problem list)
- Date enrolled in hospice care
- Date of death with major cause of death




## **Demographics**

- 1. Click \_\_\_\_\_ to enter date when the patient is enrolled in hospice care.
- 2. Click Edit to update information.



3. Select **Hospice** from the drop-down list for **Patient Status**.



4. Enter the Date of Hospice Enrollment using the calendar widget.




5. Any Hospice Notes may be added to the comment box.




6. Click SAVE




7. Click Edit to update status with date of death.



8. Click on **Deceased** in the **Patient Status** drop-down list.




- 9. Select the date of death using the calendar widget.
- 10. Click ADD DETAILS



- 11. If major cause of death was related to the patient's cancer diagnosis click

  Hem/Onc Disease
  - If Hem/Onc Disease is selected the patient will be included in the denominator.
  - When the Cause of Death is not documented the patient will be included in the denominator by default.
  - If Other is selected the patient will not be included in the denominator.
  - If left blank, it will be assumed the cause of death was related to the cancer diagnosis and will be included in the denominator.
- 12. Click SAVE



13. Scroll down and click **SAVE** for the demographics tab.
